CONTEST GUIDELINES



1. Any child between the ages of 2 through 17 may enter. Multiple entries will be accepted.

2. Draw or paint on a piece of paper or poster board.

a. Individual submissions: 8 ½ " x 11"

b. Group submissions: 8 ½" x 14" or 12" x 12"

Use brushes, pencils, acrylics, watercolors, crayons or any other media that you wish.

3. Portray in your drawing whatever you imagine about other countries. Think about their languages, heroes, culture, art, architecture. There is a lot to imagine!

4. Write the following on the back of your drawing: your complete name, age, address, home phone number, e-mail and school name.

5. Fill out the attached form and don't forget that all the information is important. You could be disqualified if you leave something out.

6. Give your drawing a title and on the back of your drawing or on a separate piece of paper, write a short description of what you are expressing with it.

7. Send your drawing (directly or through your school) to ASU Preparatory Academy, Art Contest, 735 E. Fillmore St, Phoenix AZ 85006. It must be received no later than March 31, 2012.

8. A panel composed of children and adults will choose art contest winners by age group.

9. Winners will be announced on April 14, 2012 at the 6th Annual International Languages Expo for Youth and on the following websites: www.isaz.org and www.asuprep.asu.edu.

10. Winners will have their art showcased on the ISA website. They will also receive a certificate mailed to them at the address listed on their registration form as well as a foreign language children's book or gift card.

11. Copied or traced drawings will not be considered for judging. Drawings done with the help of an adult will not be accepted. Drawings missing required information or exceeding the measurements indicated above will also be disqualified.

12. Copyrights of the drawings will be ceded to the International School of Arizona which may use them for promotional purposes.
