

2011/12 School Uniform Guidelines

The International School of Arizona's uniform program for the 2011/12 School Year encompasses all grade levels (pre-school and elementary). The policy requires that students wear a specified school uniform following the guidelines below.

Uniform Guidelines



All embroidered logo apparel should be ordered from **New City Promotions/Company Casuals, Lands' End, or French Toast**. Pants, shorts and skirts do not need to be purchased from the provided vendors but must follow uniform guidelines.

Tops: Any collared shirt or blouse with the ISA logo. Polo dresses or jumpers are allowed but must be embroidered with the logo, available from Land's End only.

Color Choices (Land's End): Red, Maize, Evergreen, Pink, Chambray Blue, Cobalt, White or Classic Navy

Color Choices (Company Casuals): Red, Green, Cobalt Blue or White

Color Choices (French Toast): Red, Navy, or White.

Bottoms: Long dress pants, shorts or skirts. (**No Jeans**)

Color Choices: Tan or Navy

Following the ISA school uniform policy is the first sign of cooperation and readiness to begin each day with an emphasis on academics. It is expected that all students will attend school each day in a uniform that is clean and fits properly. Enrollment at the school requires compliance with this school policy.

Uniform Violations: *ISA will notify the student's parents of the violation. The parent will be asked to bring appropriate clothing, purchase clothing from ISA, or the student will be required to put on clothing checked out from the ISA uniform closet. Students who are in repeated violation of the uniform policy may not be allowed to attend class.*
